Drawings, Specifications and/or Proposals are herein amended, expanded and/or modified, as hereinafter described, and become a part of the Contract Documents with the same force and effect as if incorporated, therein, originally. Any contrary provisions contained, or referred to, in Drawings and/or Specifications, shall remain applicable unless overridden by this Addendum. Revised or contrary provisions herein shall not affect any other part of the Contract Documents and any deletions, additions, substitutions and/or revisions mentioned, shall include all labor, materials, methods, modifications, etc. required for complete performance of the work.

This Addendum No. 2 consists of two (2) pages.

**SPECIAL PROVISIONS**

- Add Special Provisions #14 and #15.
  14. Light fixtures (2) shall be mounted on a treated wood post with minimum 6-inch by 6-inch dimensions. A round treated wood utility pole may be substituted having a minimum diameter of 12 inches. Poles shall be installed as direct embedment a minimum of 6 feet below finished grade.

15. Crushed Limestone, 4-inch shall consist of a crushed limestone or granite based material meeting the following gradation requirements:

<u>Sieve Size</u>	<u>Total Percent Passing</u>
3/8"	100
1/4"	85-100
#4	65-85
#6	40-65
#16	30-40
#30	25-30
#50	20-25
#100	15-20
#200	10-20

Alternate gradations will be allowed meeting the requirements of the Michigan DNR Universal Design Guidelines.

### **CLARIFICATIONS**

1. The existing electrical service to the park is located at the west end of the existing pavilion. Contractor shall provide all necessary wire, circuit breakers and equipment to connect the two (2) proposed light fixtures to the existing circuit panel at the pavilion. The contractor will be responsible for sizing of wire, electrical permit fees and all other costs associated with providing and installing power to the light fixtures in accordance with applicable local and State electric codes.
